Updates

Doane's Board of Trustees met the week of Oct. 2 — and members of Staff Council joined them in committee sessions, where we asked your questions and made note of decisions that affect staff. While we can't share everything (the committee meetings can include sensitive information) we are compiling a cohesive document with answers to your contributed questions to share in our November update.

With the recent decision to outsource Doane's custodial services some Staff Council members have been questioned if this decision was vetted through the Shared Governance ARC - Approve, Recommend, Consult process. The answer is yes. Staff Council Chair Brandon Rieschick and Chair-elect Brad Jenny, as well as Faculty Council's chairs, were consulted about the decision to make this change prior to it being announced.

Any staff who have questions about the ARC Matrix can reach out to Quinn Stryker or Denise Ellis as they are the designated staff representatives on the University Shared Governance Committee (USGC).

On this — with the reduction in members of Group 1, Staff Council will likely need to amend our bylaws so that groups remain similar in size. We want our representation to be consistent. And having more people in each group ensures that feedback can't be directly attributed to specific staff members. For now, members of Group 1 can share feedback with our At-Large representatives or chairs.

We're considering an all staff assembly and want your thoughts! Before the start of the academic year, Faculty Council leads Fall Faculty Days, which includes presentations on different subjects. We want to know — is there something you can speak to that would benefit all staff members? Is there something you want to know more about?
